

Štěpánka Zemanová, Ph.D., is an Associate Professor and Head of the Department of International and Diplomatic Studies at the Faculty of International Relations, Prague University of Economics and Business. In her capacity, she oversees the design and implementation of undergraduate and graduate programmes specialising in International Studies and Diplomacy. Her research interests cover economic diplomacy, economic statecraft, international sanctions, and political and economic aspects of international human rights protection.

Her engagement in international scholarly networks began with the Young Scholars International Conference in Prague, where she held various organisational posts. Since 2016, she has been deeply involved in international scholarly associations, focusing on strengthening global and regional academic cooperation. She served for six years as a member of the Central and East European International Studies Association Executive Committee and, from 2019 to 2022, was one of the leaders in the initiative to establish the Global International Relations Section within International Studies Association (ISA). In this role, she actively contributed to securing support for the submission of a petition to the ISA Governing Council. Following the creation of the section, she has continued to serve on its Executive Committee.
