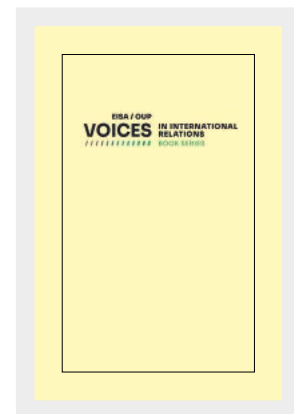

# SEMI-PLENARIES, 1 JULY 2026

## Roundtable 1 From Anxiety to Agency: Navigating Multi-Dimensional Insecurities in the 21st Century

*This semi-plenary session examines multi-dimensional insecurities and global crises in an era of systemic fracture that often results in collective anxiety, paralysis, and violence. Against this background, escalating regional conflicts, climate disasters, and reactionary politics invite a natural pessimism. However, the session evaluates these dislocations not only as causes of pervasive anxiety but also as potential sources of productive spaces for critical scholarship to explore resistance, rage, and the need of repair.*

*To this end, the semi-plenary theme invites a critical interrogation of the failure of the international institutional order across different approaches, intellectual moods, theoretical lenses, and analytical sensibilities. It specifically seeks to focus on the rise of non-Western assertiveness, deepening inequalities, crises of social reproduction, as well as the civilizational turn in global politics. By examining the intersections between existential risks such as instrumentalised AI expansion and authoritarian consolidation, and emerging struggles for survival and solidarity, the session aims to explore new frameworks for global governance. These frameworks seek to transcend traditional hegemony and open up spaces for solidarity, recognizing how anxiety, when reflexively managed, can foster creativity, radical agency, and progressive transformation in the 21<sup>st</sup> century.*

## Roundtable 2 Exit from Emergency? Reimagining the Middle East and Global Orders through Survival and Repair

*This semi-plenary session engages with the Middle East as a region where the tensions of the contemporary international order are not only clearly visible but also acutely lived and confronted. While experiencing the consequences of what has been described as a “fracture time” or an “age of emergency”, literature and activism in the region has long exposed and opposed the normalization of wars and violence, overlapping crises and imperial politics. This, without a doubt, entails an urgency of analytical and ethical reflection and deliberation by the broader scholarly community.*

*Indeed, the Middle East offers a critical lens for rethinking central questions in IR related to global order and disorder. Persistent armed conflict and genocide, forced displacement, struggles for survival, economic volatility, and technological disruption are indeed the constituents of wider transformations in international politics. Thus, by bringing together diverse scholarly perspectives, this session aims to discuss potential alternative futures in the Middle East and beyond by offering new vocabularies of international cooperation, repair, and solidarity.*

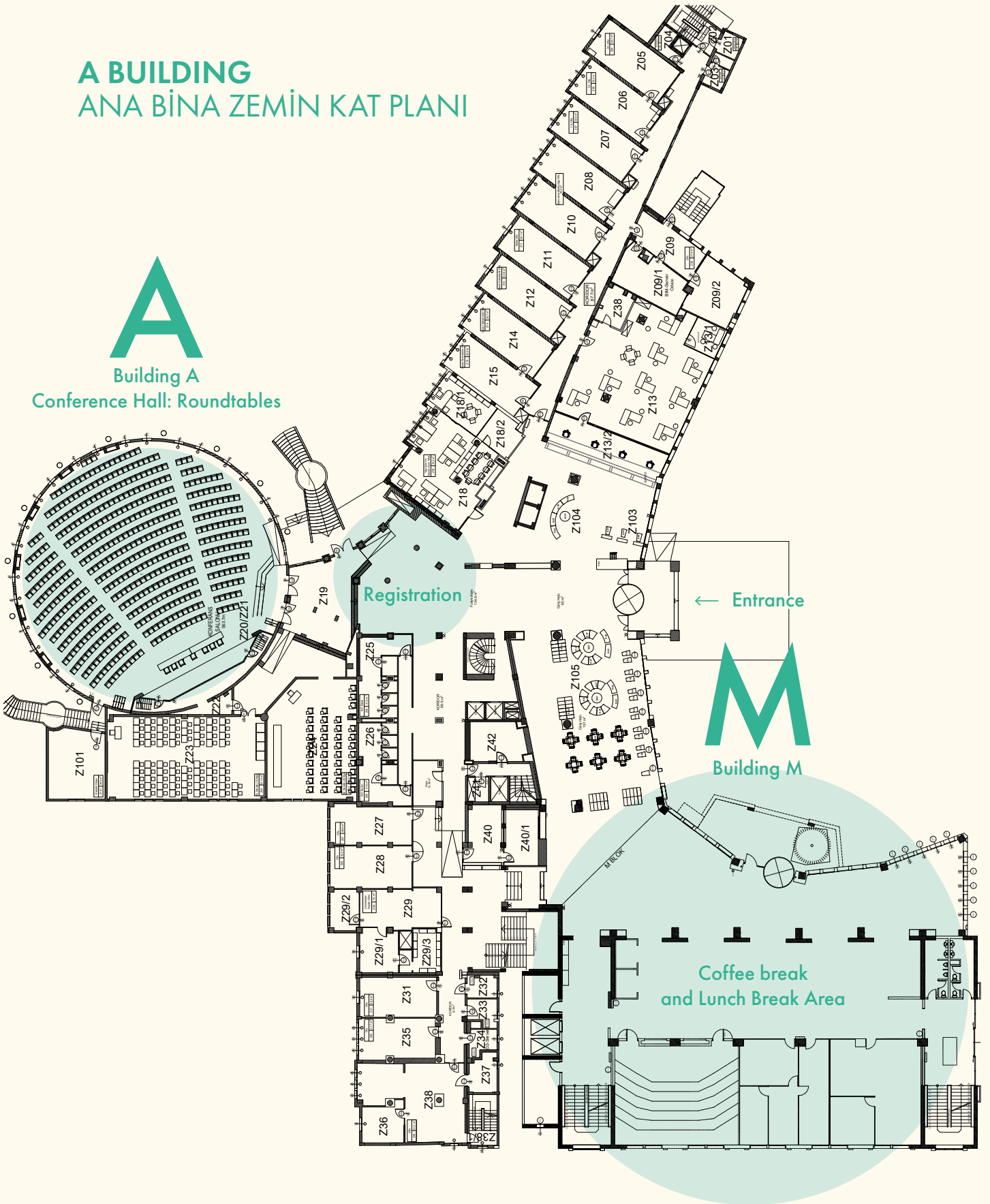

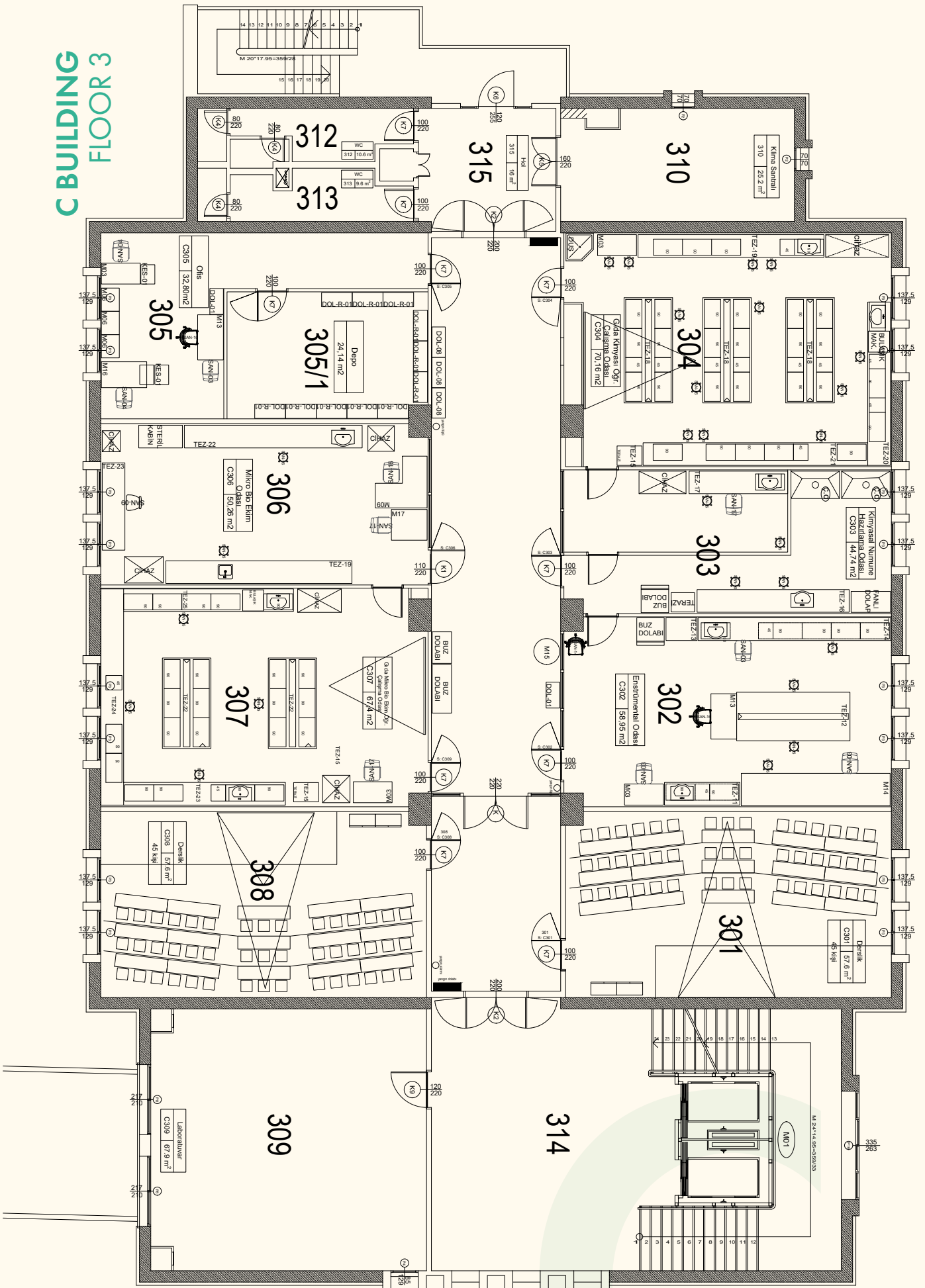




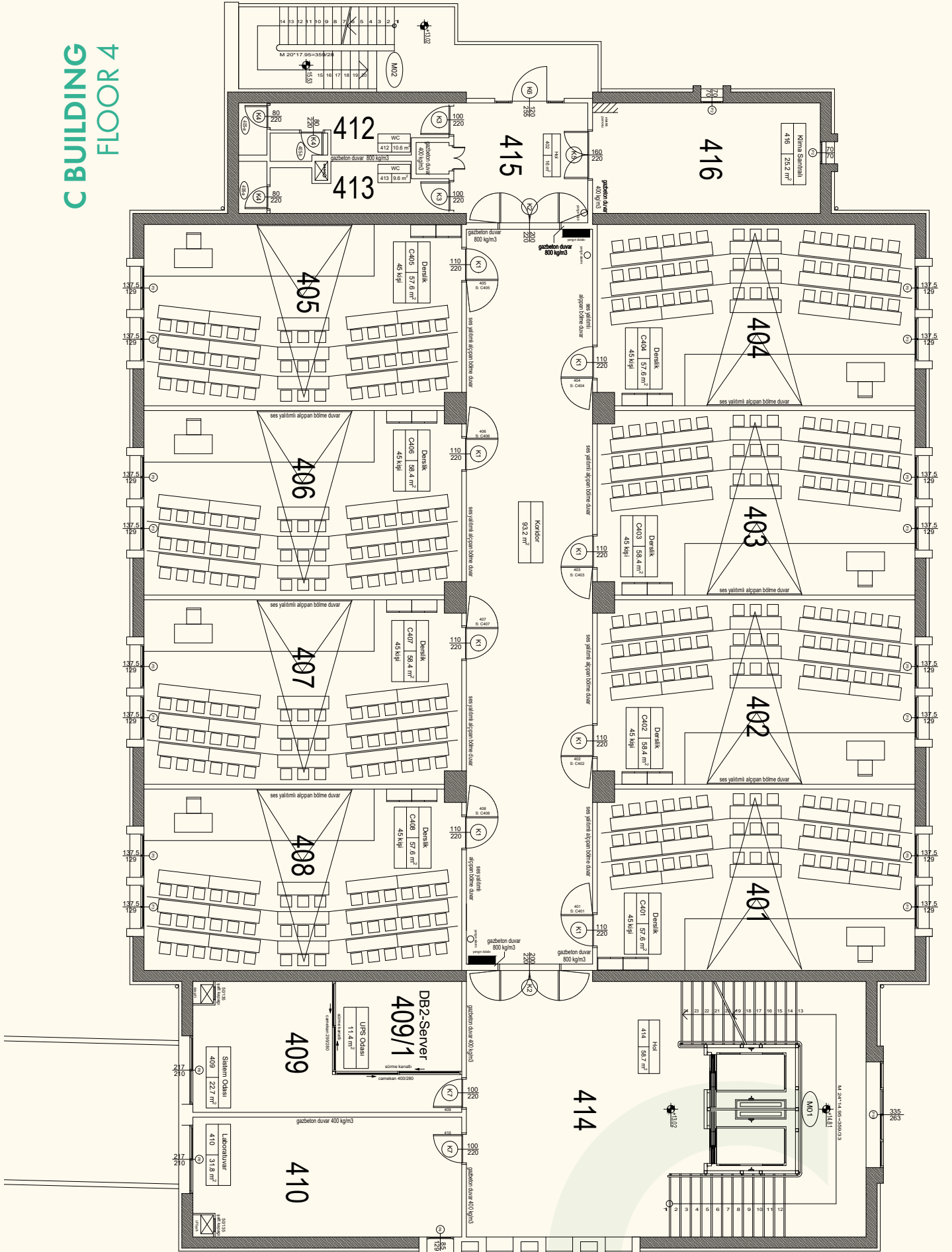




# C BUILDING FLOOR 3

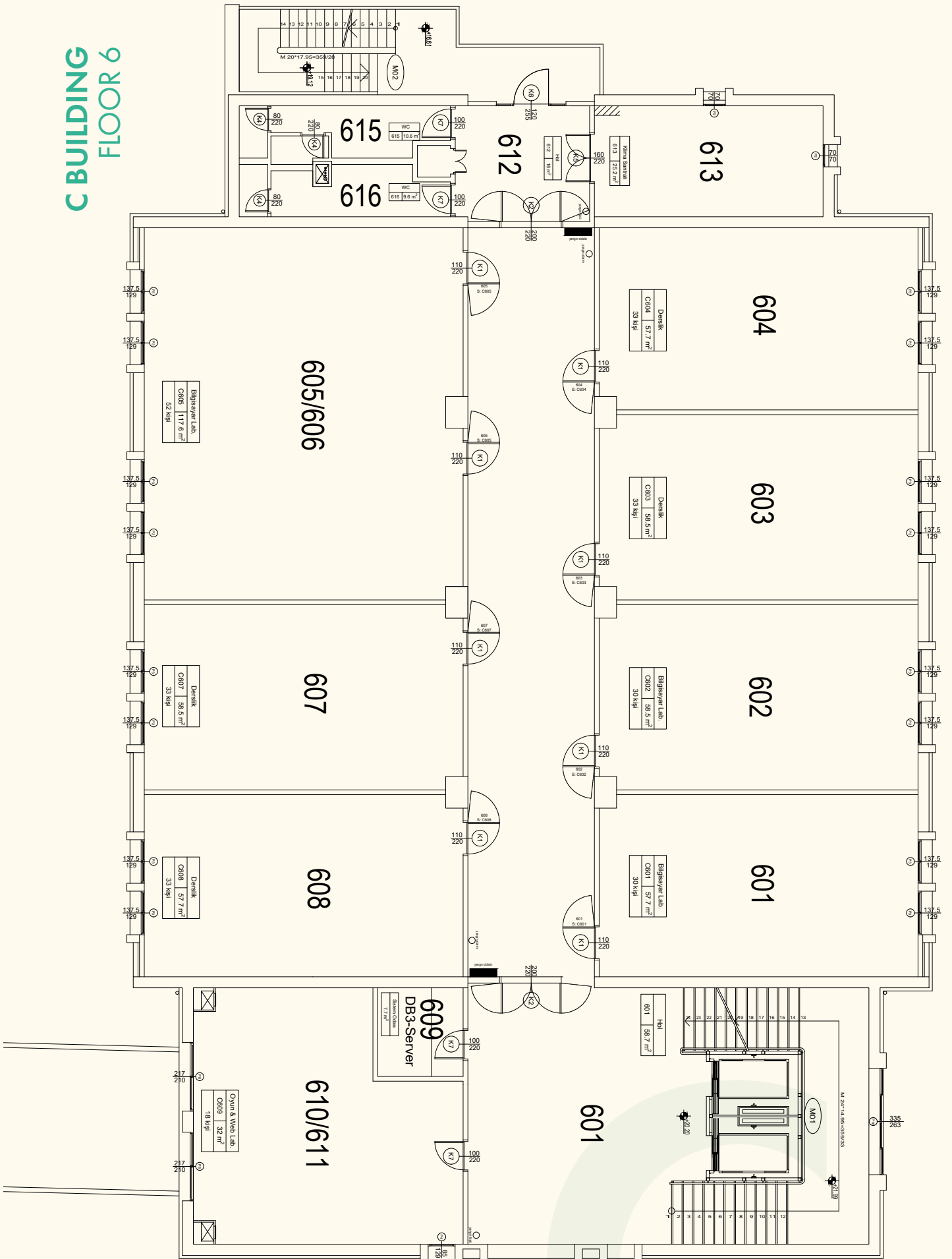
